



NATIONAL HISPANIC HEALTH PROFESSIONAL STUDENT 2008-2009 SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The National Hispanic Health Foundation, affiliated with Robert F. Wagner Graduate School of Public Service, New York University, will award 20 scholarships to dental, medical, nursing, public health, and policy students who exhibit exceptional academic performance, leadership, and commitment to the Hispanic community. Ten applicants from New York & New Jersey and ten applicants from California will be selected. The three highest ranked recipients will receive \$5,000, and the remaining 17 recipients will receive \$2,000. The scholarships will be presented to the ten New York/New Jersey awardees at the Fifth Annual New York Scholarship Gala at the Marriott Marquis Hotel in New York City on Thursday, December 4, 2008. The ten California awardees will be honored at the Second Annual California Scholarship Gala at the Sheraton Grand Hotel in Sacramento on Wednesday, February 11, 2009.

**Applicants currently must be enrolled full-time and seeking a professional degree at medical, dental, nursing, public health, or policy schools in New York/New Jersey or California (pre-health not eligible).

**Applicants are not required to be Hispanic; an affinity for the health of Hispanic communities is needed.

**Past applicants not awarded may re-apply; past recipients of funding may not.

New York/New Jersey applications are due Friday, November 7, 2008.

California applications must be received by Friday, January 9, 2009.
